GUIDELINES FOR THE JUNE B. LEE ADVOCACY AWARD

The Spotlight Committee awards the June B. Lee Advocacy award to a JCTA member who has demonstrated exemplary advocacy.

- 1. The June B. Lee Advocacy award may be bestowed upon any JCTA member who has demonstrated through their actions outstanding advocacy for JCTA.
- 2. Nominators will be asked to summarize how the nominee has met the following guidelines in terms of actions in support of JCTA and public education:
 - a. What contribution has the nominee made to teachers, school and/or students?
 - b. How has this contribution supported JCTA and/or public education?
 - c. If nominee has made written or oral statements of advocating for teacher/public education, please attach supporting documentation.
- 3. Individuals must be nominated by a JCTA member. Please, no self-nominations.
- 4. The Spotlight Committee will review applications for the award and make recommendations to the JCTA President. In the event of any disagreement with the Committee's selection, the recommendation with supporting and opposing rationale will be presented to the JCTA Board of Directors. The decision of the JCTA Board will be final.
- 5. Applications for this award <u>MUST</u> be received in the JCTA office by Jan. 14 at 5:00 p.m. Applications received after Jan. 14 at 5:00 p.m. will not be considered.
