3. Each performing arts entry can be any type of performing art as long as it is original and is no more than 5 minutes in length.
4. The speech entry must be of one student performing Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s "I Have a Dream" speech.
5. All entries must be submitted on video tapes or DVDs.
6. Performing arts pieces and speeches will be judged in the following categories: Middle (6-8), High (9-12) and ECE.

Awards:

The winner in each category will receive a \$75 savings bond and will be invited to an awards dinner on January the 19th or 26th. The final date and location will be announced at a later date.
