3. The entries can be any type of visual art (poster, painting, sculpture, diorama, shadowbox, etc.).
4. On the back or bottom of each entry, the following information must be included: the student's name, category/level, teacher's name and school.
5. Works must be original; no copies, stencils or clip art.
6. Art will be judged in the following categories: Middle (6-8), ECE Middle (6-8), High (9-12) and ECE High (9-12).

## **Awards:**

The winner in each category will receive a \$75 savings bond and will be invited to an awards dinner on January the 19<sup>th</sup> or 26<sup>th</sup>. The final date and location will be announced at a later date.
