Contest Rules:

1. Entries will be judged on how well they reflect this year's theme.
2. Each teacher may submit no more than five entries.
3. The entries can be any type visual art (poster, painting, sculpture, diorama, shadowbox, etc.).
4. On the back or bottom of each entry, the following information must be included: the student's name, category/level, teacher's name and school.
5. Works must be original; no copies, stencils or clip art.
6. Art will be judged in the following categories: Pre-K, Primary (K-3), ECE Primary (K-3), Intermediate (4-5), ECE Intermediate (4-5), Middle (6-8), ECE Middle (6-8), High (9-12) and ECE High (9-12).

Awards:

The winner in each category will receive a \$100 savings bond and will be invited to an awards dinner on January 25, 2010 at the UAW Hall – Local 862 (3000 Fern Valley Rd). JCTA will also sponsor (pay for the bus and tickets) a trip for five of the winners' classes to the Louisville Orchestra's Martin Luther King, Jr. concert, which will be held Friday, January 15, 2010 at 9:30 a.m. These lucky winners will be chosen by random following the initial judging.
