#### **Contest Rules:**

- 4. Writing pieces must comply with the JCPS writing rubric (appropriate to the grade level).
- 5. Writing may be typed or handwritten and must be done on white 8 ½ X 11 paper.
- 6. Writing pieces have a maximum length of two (2) typed or handwritten pages.
- 7. Each entry must have a cover sheet that includes the following information: the student's name, category/level, teacher's name and school.
- 8. Entries must be original.
- 9. The writing will be judged in the following categories: Middle (6-8), ECE Middle (6-8), High (9-12) and ECE High (9-12).

#### Awards:

The winner in each category will receive a \$75 savings bond and will be invited to an awards dinner on January the 19<sup>th</sup> or 26<sup>th</sup>. The final date and location will be announced at a later date.
